



How to Properly Care for Your Wrap

Taking care of your vehicle, trailer or truck wrap is vital in order to enjoy the many benefits of the wrap for years to come. We are commonly asked questions about how to properly care for your wrap. The following are three important steps to remember after your wrap installation:

1. Hand Wash Only

Taking your wrap through an automatic car wash can damage it due to excessive water pressure and strong cleaning agents. We recommend hand washing your wrap with only a mild cleanser. Mechanical car washes are not advised and will void the install guarantee.

2. No Harsh Chemicals

Don't use any harsh cleaning agents or allow gasoline to drip on your wrap. Gas and other harsh solvents will eat away at the laminate and destroy the print. Also, avoid using abrasive cleaning supplies that might scratch your wrap.

3. Don't Use Paste Wax on your Wrap

If you hand wax your paint, make sure the wax is non-abrasive. Here are a few car care products that you can use to help protect your investment.

4. Take Action

Outdoor elements can be rough on your wrap, especially when working on construction sites. If you see a part of your wrap peeling up from weather or road wear, contact Transport Graphics to see how to correct it quickly. It will be better and easier to correct if you take action sooner than later.
